### 6. Open Items

Manny Seage commented about the existing conditions of the golf cart paths at the Granada Golf Course. Fred Couceyro said that he is aware and put in a request to fix the golf cart paths. Manny also said that there are no park rangers out on the golf courses. Fred said that there are cost issues with park rangers and worker's compensation laws that prevent the Biltmore Hotel from hiring volunteer park rangers. We have a starter then the Interim Superintendent drives around and acts an enforcer. Robert Ruano inquired about the Alexander Palms being planted around Coral Gables; Robert said that people hit these palms knocking them down and that people consider these palms to be invasive. Jessica Keller explained that trees with smaller trunk diameters are selected because they will break away if hit by a car. This is particularly important where there is less than 4' from face of curb to tree. He also asked about the tree and plant selection process. Fred Couceyro said that the City has an Arborist and a Landscape Beautification Board that helps with this process.
