You, as the Owner and/or Occupant of the premises at:

630 SAN SERVANDO AVE

are in violation of the following sections of the City Code of the City of Coral Gables:

Sec. 82-29. - Permits generally.

(e)Pruning of trees on public property and rights-of-way. The pruning of any trees on public property and rights-of-way is prohibited unless expressly approved by the tree preservation agency in advance.

The following steps should be taken to correct the violation:

Remedy: Obtain all necessary permits as per Chapter 82-29. Must obtain an after the fact permit for tree cutting. Must contact Coral Gables Greenspace for additional requirements and tree mitigation. (305) 460-5131

As a result of the above violation(s), a complaint has been filed against you and you are hereby commanded to appear before the Code Enforcement Board for a hearing on 11/15/2023 at 08:30 AM in the Commission Chambers, located on the second floor of:

This is your notice to appear at said time and place. Failure to do so will result in the matter being heard in absentia. An administrative fee of \$108.75 will be assessed at the time of your hearing.

Please be advised that if someone will be attending the hearing on your behalf, he or she must provide a power of attorney from you at the time of the hearing.

If this notice pertains to failure to maintain a historic structure, please be advised that:

- · You may be subject to substantial fines that may not be mitigated
- You may also be required to repair or restore the historic structure.
- If the historic structure is allowed to deteriorate to the point where it must be demolished:
 - The City Code requires that you replace the structure with a similar historically appropriate structure; and
 - The property will no longer qualify for an historic preservation tax exemption
