RESOLUTION NO. 2014-

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A \$81,880.50 GRANT ON BEHALF OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MIAMI POLICE DEPARTMENT FROM THE 2011-2012 DOMESTIC SECURITY K-20 TARGET HARDENING/ACCESS CONTROL GRANT; AND AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2013-2014 ANNUAL BUDGET TO RECOGNIZE THE GRANT AS REVENUE, AND TO APPROPRIATE SUCH FUNDS TO REIMBURSE THE UNIVERSITY OF MIAMI POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE GRANT EXPENDITURES.

WHEREAS, the Coral Gables Police Department is the established local law enforcement agency for the provision of law enforcement services within the jurisdictional boundaries of the City of Coral Gables; and

WHEREAS, the 2011-2012 Domestic Security K-20 Hardening/Access Control Grant awarded UMPD a \$81,880.50 grant to purchase equipment for the target hardening of the University of Miami campus; and

WHEREAS, the Coral Gables Police Department is serving in the role of intermediary in regards to this grant due to the fact that the Florida Department of Law Enforcement does not recognize UMPD as a law enforcement entity; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 Annual Budget is requested to recognize the \$81,880.50 grant as revenue, and to appropriate such funds to reimburse UMPD for the grant expenditures.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission hereby authorizes the acceptance and reimbursement to UMPD of the funds pursuant to the 2011-2012 Domestic Security K-20 Hardening/Access Control Grant.

SECTION 3. That the City Commission hereby authorizes an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 Annual Budget to recognize the \$81,880.50 grant as revenue, and to appropriate such funds to reimburse UMPD for the grant expenditures.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
