TESTING TYPES



- Two kinds of tests are available for COVID-19: [viral tests](#) and [antibody tests](#).
- A viral test tells you if you have a current infection.
- An antibody test tells you if you had a previous infection.
- An antibody test may not be able to show if you have a current infection, because it can take 1-3 weeks after infection to make antibodies.

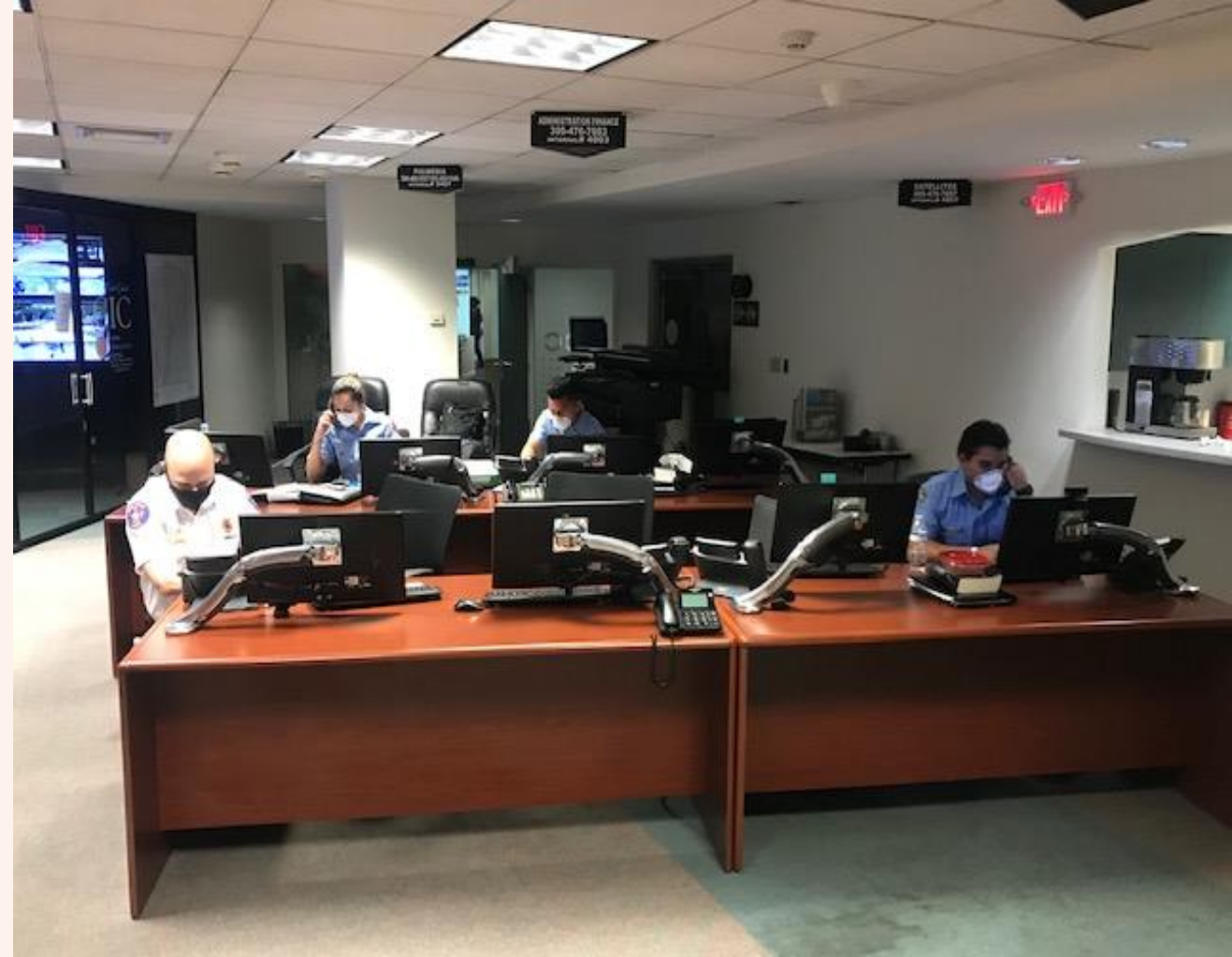


- Coral Gables Fire Department Firefighter Paramedics conduct the PCR Swab tests at home

TESTING PRIORITY

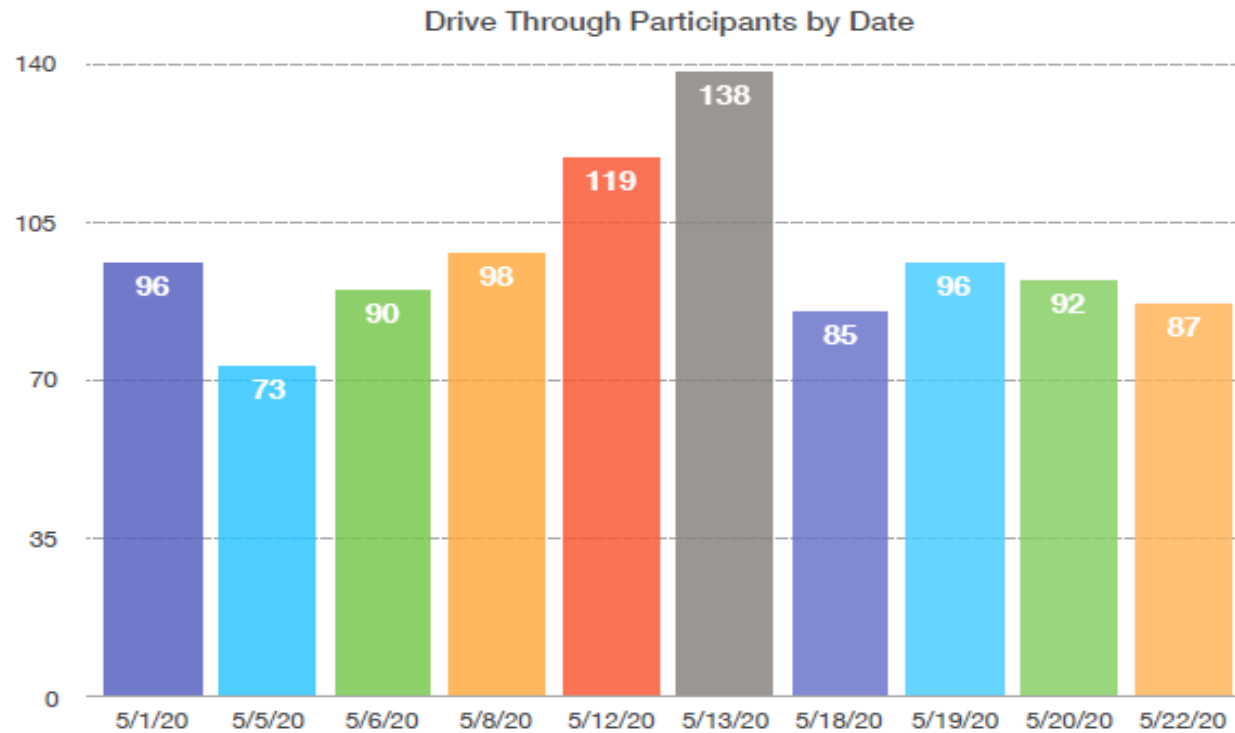
***Please select which priority best fits your current condition.**

- PRIORITY 1 - Coral Gables senior resident age 65+ with symptoms or with underlying medical conditions.
- PRIORITY 2 - Coral Gables resident under the age of 65 with symptoms or with underlying medical conditions.
- PRIORITY 3 - **Residents who do not meet any of the above priorities are not currently being scheduled**, however names will be placed on the waiting list.

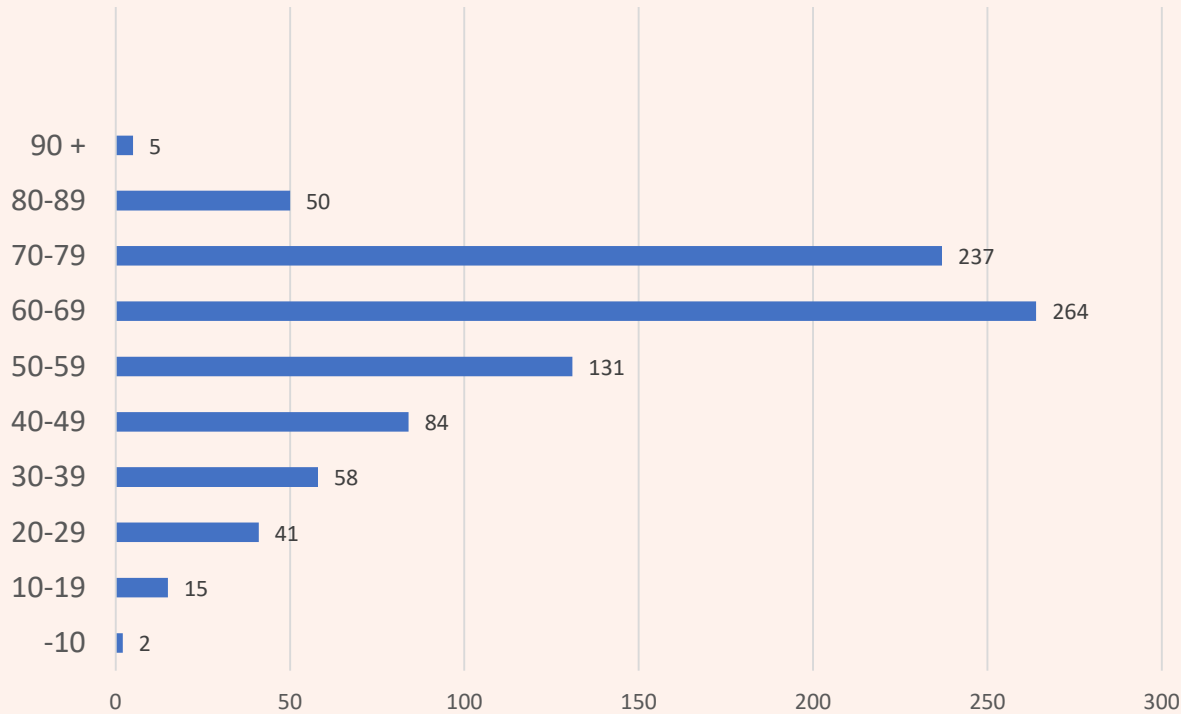

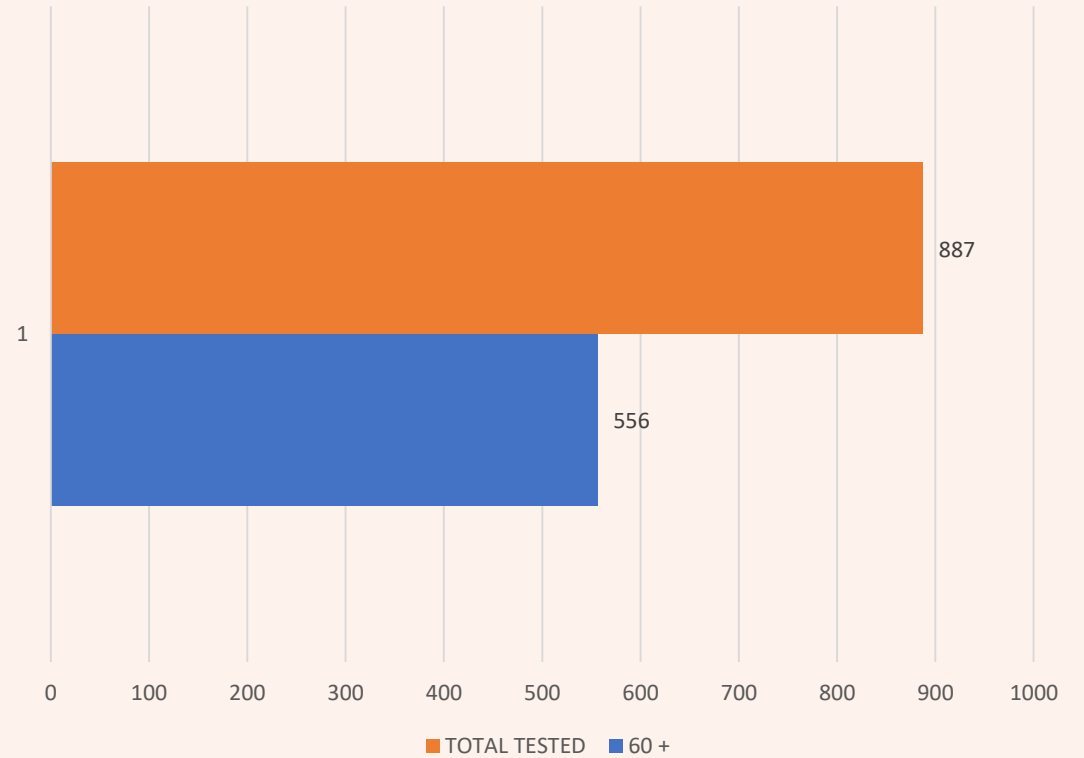

MOVING FORWARD



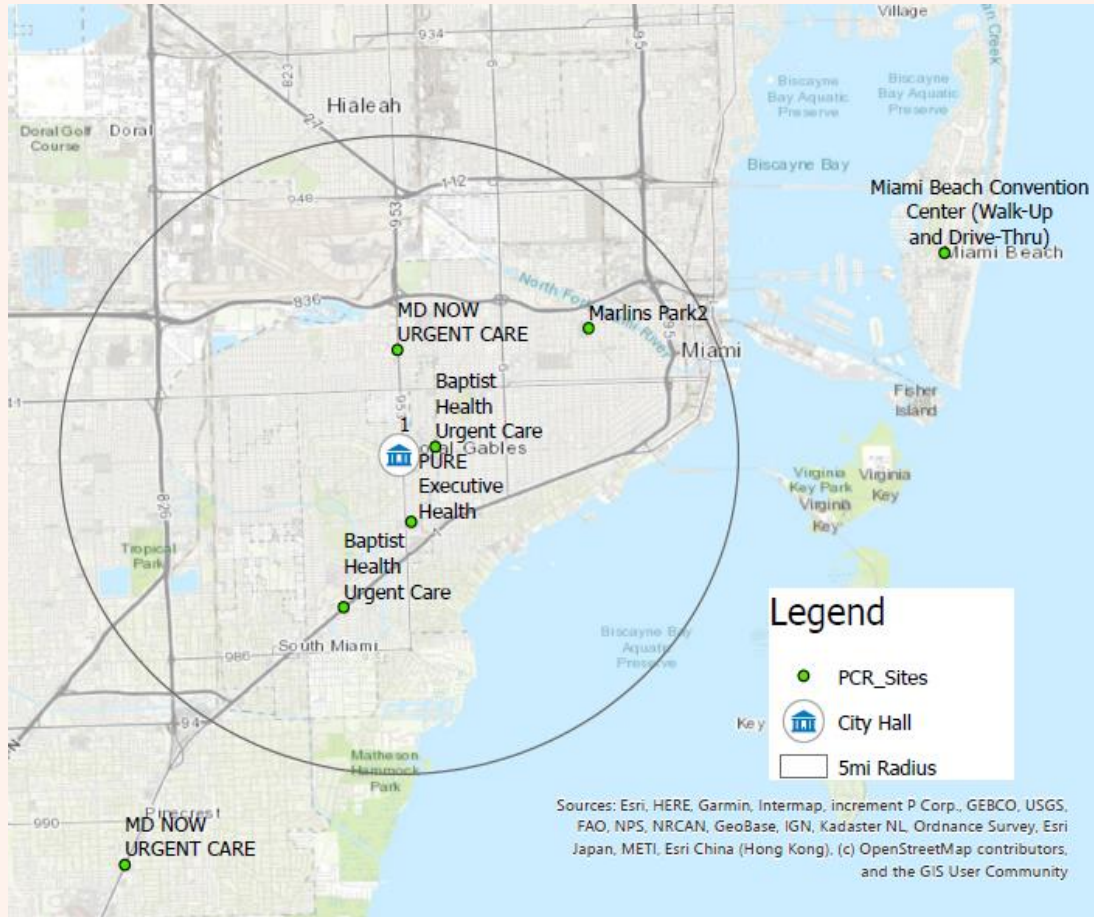
- 1,565 residents have been processed through May 27, 2020
- Average 30% No-Show or Cancellation rate
- 1,156 residents tested (projected)
- May 27th will conclude the onsite testing program
- Total Program Cost: \$110,700 through May 27, 2020

MOVING FORWARD



- Testing infrastructure will remain in place in the event that there is a resurgence due to re-opening
- Coral Gables Fire Rescue paramedics continue testing senior residents and individuals over the age of 18 with disabilities who are symptomatic and homebound
- Resident Hotline will remain in place for inquiries and needs

ANTIBODY TEST (SEROLOGICAL TEST)



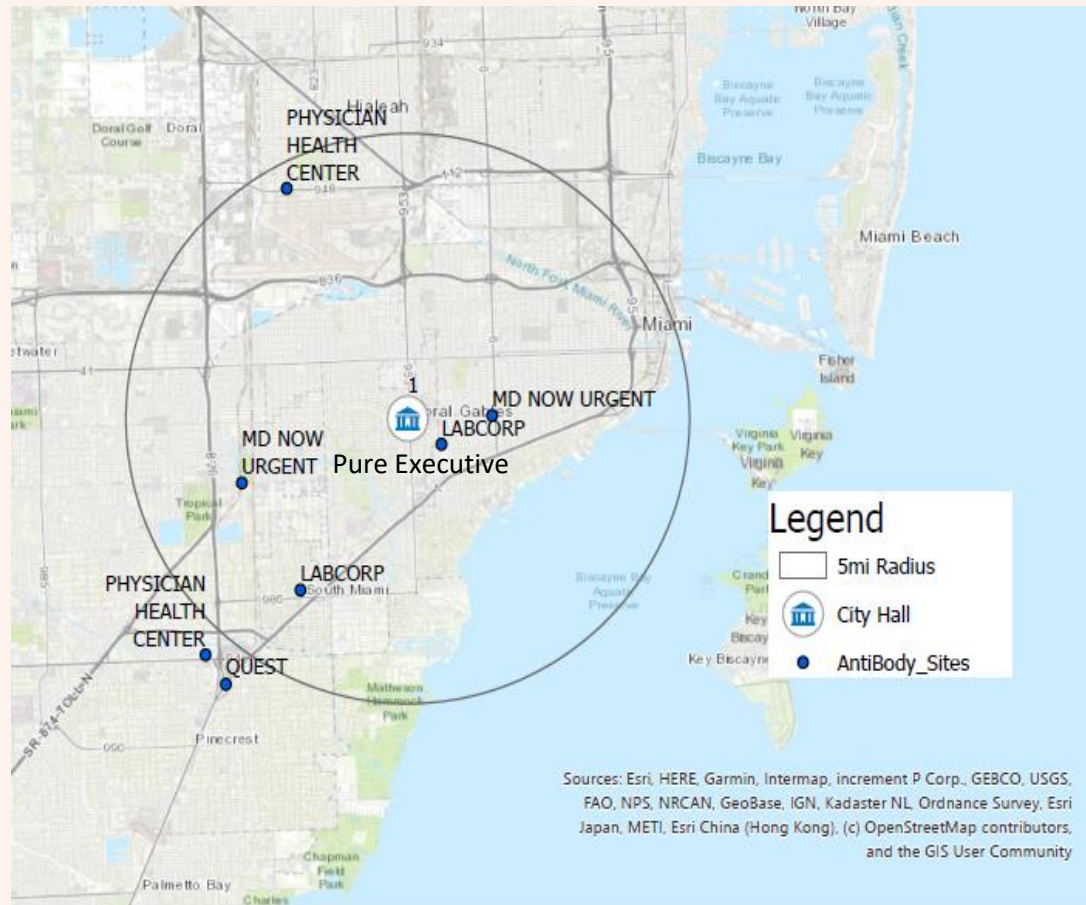
- Detects the presence of antibody in the blood
- Identifies an immune response to the virus
- Epidemiological tool for surveillance utilized to determine extent of exposure in a community
- **Not a Diagnostic Tool**

ANTIBODY TEST (SEROLOGICAL TEST)



- There are no FDA Approved Serological Test currently available
- All available test have Emergency Use Authorization from the FDA
 - Means that the tests reliability or performance is currently under evaluation
 - Tests in the market have not been validated
 - Emerging technology a lot of unknowns with the different types of tests
- There is no City currently providing Serological Testing
 - State providing anti-body testing for HCP and First Responders only
