Ambassadors have also dealt with several dead animals on the Mile.









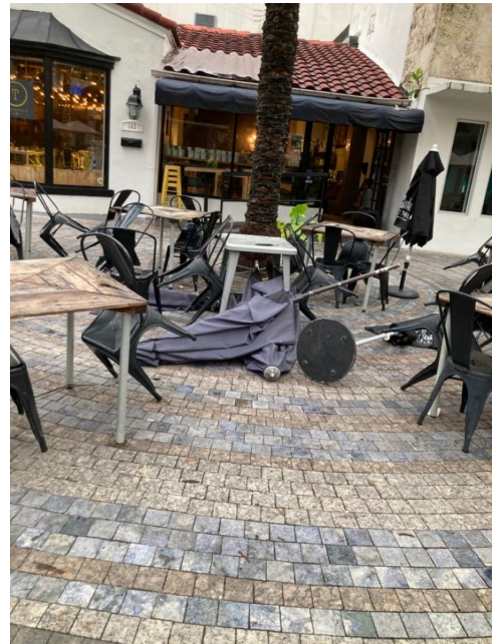














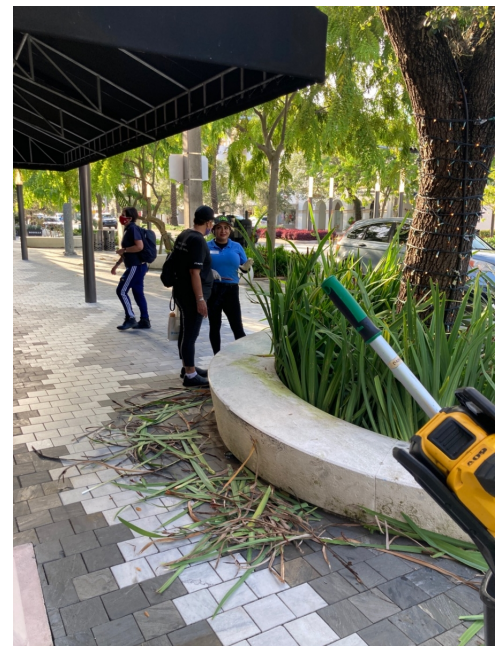


# Hospitality Highlights
