Coral Gables Golf and Country Club Reopening Timeline – First Week

- Complete building assessment for short term and long-term maintenance and infrastructure needs.
- Removal of waste and litter throughout the building.
- Clearing the building of perishable goods in preparation of termite tenting.
- Installation of Information Technology infrastructure.
- Pool plumbing and pump repairs.
- Demolition & repairs to café seating area ceilings and rafters.
- Execution of operational plan for the fitness center and the café space.
- Landscaping and tree trimmings in preparation of tenting.
- Pressure cleaning of service entrance and dumpster replacement.
- Building rekeying and securing of exterior access points.



Coral Gables Golf and Country Club Reopening Timeline – Second Week

- Tenting of the entire building and subterranean termite treatment.
- Custodial cleaning of the entire building.
- Exterior painting and repairs following vine removal.
- Commence landscaping and exterior beautification projects.
- Interior painting and minor repairs throughout the entire building.
- Epoxy coating of delaminated kitchen floors.
- Commence air conditioning and refrigeration system repairs.
- Clean and recertify hood and kitchen exhaust and suppression system.
- Continuation of Information Technology infrastructure.



Coral Gables Golf and Country Club Reopening Timeline – Third Week

- Ballroom hard wood floor restoration.
- Pool leak detection, repairs and pool bottom acid wash.
- Electrical repairs.
- Window restoration and door replacements.
- Exterior pool elevator repairs.
- Preparation for delivery and installation of new fitness equipment.
- Continuation of landscaping, painting, air conditioning repairs.
- Continuation of Information Technology infrastructure.
- Continuation of roof repairs.
- Continuation of kitchen improvements.

Membership Details


Memberships include amenities such as the fitness center, steam room, pool, and tennis courts with an initial two-court limit and programming discounts.

Concessionaire Agreement with Revenue Split


Revenues based on sales.
