RESOLUTION NO. 2010-176

RESOLUTION GRANTING PERMISSION TO MIAMI-DADE PUBLIC SCHOOLS USAGE OF PHILLIPS PARK FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACTIVITIES FOR THE 2010-2011 SCHOOL YEAR, IN ACCORDANCE WITH EDUCATION COMPACT AS SPECIFIED IN RESOLUTION NO. 2006-57.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. That the City Commission does hereby grant permission, because Coral Gables Elementary has now been expanded to a K through 8 School, and the Merrick Educational Center will now house the middle school portion of the "Coral Gables K through 8 Preparatory Academy at Merrick Educational Center." In addition, during the upcoming school year, the Academy will use Phillips Park for its physical education activities during school days, and these activities will consist of sports and games.

SECTION 2. That the school will not have exclusive use of the park, and does not wish to use the playground or bathroom facilities in the park; further stipulating that the requested use is in accordance with the education compact between the City and Miami-Dade Public Schools.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
