RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A RED LIGHT CAMERA INFRACTION HEARING OFFICER ACCOUNT ENTITLED “RED LIGHT CAMERA HEARING” TO ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM AND APPROVING THE APPROPRIATION FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED TWENTY FIVE DOLLARS (\$2,625.00) IN THE 2009-2010 ANNUAL BUDGET.

WHEREAS, Ordinance Numbers 2007-35, 2009-1 and 2009-54 created the Red Light Camera legislation penalizing and assessing fees against motor vehicle owners who violate red light traffic signals and provided for a Code Enforcement Hearing Officer to consider appeals of citations issued for red light traffic signal violations; and

WHEREAS, a Red Light Camera Infraction Hearing Officer account entitled “Red Light Camera Hearing” to administer the payment of services rendered by the hearing officer is necessary; and

WHEREAS, the 2009-2010 Annual Budget is hereby amended to include an appropriation in the amount of two thousand six hundred twenty-five dollars (\$2,625.00) in the Red Light Camera Hearing Officer account 001-1280-524-31-92 and the source of funds are from the General Fund Unappropriated Fund Balance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions inconsistent with, or in conflict herewith, shall be and are hereby repealed insofar as there is conflict or inconsistency.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption herein.
