A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA, APPOINTING INDIVIDUALS TO THE WHEEL OF SPECIAL MAGISTRATES FOR CERTAIN QUASI-JUDICIAL HEARINGS PURSUANT TO SECTION 101-135 OF THE CITY CODE.

WHEREAS, Section 101-135 of the City Code outlines the duties and responsibilities of the special magistrates who preside over red light camera hearings and code enforcement ticket hearings; and

WHEREAS, special magistrates are attorneys who are members in good-standing with the Florida Bar, who reside or maintain a business establishment for a minimum of five years within the City of Coral Gables, who possess an outstanding reputation for civic pride, integrity, fairness, objectivity, responsibility, and the appropriate legal experience or background; and

WHEREAS, the individuals being appointed pursuant to this resolution exemplify the qualities outlined above; and

WHEREAS, special magistrates shall serve a two-year term with appointments beginning on July 1st of each year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission hereby ratifies the City Manager's appointment of incumbents Ian Martinez, Oliver Langstadt, Michael Hacker, Myra Perez Damera, and Stuart Grossman as special magistrates pursuant to Section 101-135 of the City Code, for the two-year term which began July 1, 2019.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
