ITEM TITLE:

A Resolution amending previously adopted Resolution No. 2014-235 by authorizing an encumbrance in the amount of \$2,434 or 15% of the State Forfeited Asset Fund (F.A.F.) monies received in the 2013-2014 fiscal year to provide for the support and operation of school resource officer, crime prevention, safe neighborhood and drug abuse education and prevention programs, as required under the Florida Contraband Forfeiture Act.

DEPARTMENT HEAD RECOMMENDATION:

Approval.

BRIEF HISTORY:

The F.A.F. consists of the proceeds from the seizure and forfeiture of certain assets identified during criminal investigations to have been possessed or utilized in violation of the Florida Contraband Forfeiture Act. Under FSS 932.7055, the Florida Contraband Forfeiture Act, a local law enforcement agency that acquires at least \$15,000 in such proceeds in a fiscal year must expend or donate no less than 15% of forfeited asset proceeds for school resource officer, crime prevention, safe neighborhood and drug abuse education and prevention programs.

The F.A.F. Committee met on March 11, 2015 and approved this request. The original encumbrance was approved by the Committee on October 15, 2014.
