

Vice Chair Wells' proposed amendment to Section 2- Term Limitations

Sec. 2. - Term Limitations.

No person shall be elected to serve as Mayor for more than eight consecutive years. Likewise, no person shall be elected to serve as City Commissioner for more than twelve consecutive years. No person shall be chosen, appointed or elected to serve as Mayor or a Commissioner if he or she has held either such office during each of the preceding twelve consecutive years. Such person who has served either or both as Mayor and/or a Commissioner during any consecutive twelve-year period cannot be chosen, appointed or elected as Mayor or a Commissioner unless he or she has not held either such office for at least four consecutive years prior to such appointment or election.

Except as otherwise set forth above, the time served by an individual chosen, appointed or elected to fulfill an unexpired term resulting from a vacancy on the City Commission shall not be counted in applying these term limits.
