**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA, AMENDING RESOLUTION 30314-A BY ADOPTING A REVISED CITY POLICY FOR NAMING/RENAMING CITY PARKS, OPEN SPACES, AND PUBLIC FACILITIES.

**WHEREAS**, the City's current naming policy was first adopted in 2002 via Resolution No. 303014-A; and

**WHEREAS**, the policy has not been revised or updated since its adoption; and

**WHEREAS**, in recent years, the City has acquired numerous parcels of land for the purpose of creating neighborhood parks within walking distance of all neighborhoods in the City, as outlined in the Coral Gables Comprehensive Land Use Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission continues to prioritize the acquisition of new park land as demonstrated during the most recent budget hearing for FY20-21; and

**WHEREAS**, the recent creation of several new parks within the City has highlighted opportunities to improve upon the City's current naming policy, primarily as applied to parks.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:**

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

**SECTION 2.** That the City Commission hereby amends Resolution 303014-A, by adopting the attached Policy for Naming/Renaming City Parks, Open Spaces, and Public Facilities and that such policy is incorporated and made a specific part of this Resolution and supersedes all prior policies for the naming and renaming of city parks, open spaces, and public facilities.

**SECTION 3.** That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
