 The City has issued a notice that a violation(s) exists on the premises at **15 Santillane Ave.**
 The violation(s) is/are:
 City Code - Chapter 105, section 105-27. Property is in need of maintenance by one of the following: paint peeling, repairs, and/or awnings in need of repair.
Officer Comments: Exterior of property requires maintenance: Roof, awnings, and concrete steps on west side and walkway are dirty. There are also some cracks on wall in the property.

If the violation(s) has not been corrected at the time of inspection, your property will be referred to the Code Enforcement Board for review and possible action. At the time of the hearing before the Code Enforcement Board, you will have the opportunity to explain to the citizens serving on the Board the reasons why the violation(s) has not been corrected. The Board has the authority to assess a fine against you for as long as the violation(s) has not been corrected.
 You are responsible for consultation on this matter from 7:30 AM to 4:00 PM. Please do not hesitate to contact the Code Enforcement Officer below for additional assistance.
 If you are the owner of a historic structure, please be advised that:
 - Historic structures are subject to substantial fines that may not be mitigated.
 - Historic structures are subject to repair or restore the historic structure.
 - Historic structures are not allowed to deteriorate to the point where it must be demolished.
