RESOLUTION NO. 2019-253

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA, IN SUPPORT OF S. 2302, "AMERICA'S TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE ACT OF 2019".

WHEREAS, the City of Coral Gables has long supported infrastructure for electric and alternative fuel vehicles including recently adopting legislation requiring certain electric vehicle charging requirements for new construction in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coral Gables is proud to have the largest municipal fleet of electric vehicles in the state of Florida; and

WHEREAS, the City currently has 51 electric vehicles, with plans to add an additional 20 more by 2021; and

WHEREAS, on July 29, 2019 Senator John Barrasso [R-WV] introduced S. 2302, "America's Transportation Infrastructure Act of 2019", a bill to amend title 23, United States Code, to authorize funds for Federal-aid highways and highway safety construction programs, and for other purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Senate Environment and Public Works Committee voted unanimously to advance the bill on July 30, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the bill establishes a grant program, funded at \$1 billion over five years, for states and localities to build infrastructure for electric, natural gas, and hydrogen-powered vehicles along designated highway corridors; and

WHEREAS, the bill would create a working group to develop a strategy to transition the vehicle fleets of certain Federal agencies to hybrid-electric, electric, and alternative fuel vehicles to the maximum extent practicable;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. That the foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission supports S. 2302 "America's Transportation Infrastructure Act of 2019."

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein and remains in full force and effect until supplemented, amended, repealed or otherwise altered.

SECTION 4. That the City Clerk is hereby directed to send a certified copy of the resolution to the City's Congressional delegation.


