**RESOLUTION NO. 2014-211**

A RESOLUTION GRANTING PERMISSION TO THE CORAL GABLES FIREFIGHTER'S BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION TO SELL CHRISTMAS TREES, INSTALL A TEMPORARY CHAIN LINK FENCE AND USE AN INFLATABLE SANTA CLAUS, AS A DISPLAY AT 5501 GRANADA BOULEVARD, THE CORAL GABLES BAPTIST CHURCH PROPERTY, FROM NOVEMBER 22 THROUGH DECEMBER 25, 2014.

**WHEREAS**, the Coral Gables Firefighter's Benevolent Association's annual Christmas tree sale has been a tradition since 1957; and

**WHEREAS**, the operation has been managed successfully and professionally in years past;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:**

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

**SECTION 2.** That permission is hereby granted to the Coral Gables Firefighter's Benevolent Association to sell Christmas trees, install a temporary chain link fence and use an inflatable Santa Claus as a display at 5501 Granada Boulevard, the Coral Gables Baptist Church property from November 22, 2014 through December 24, 2014

**SECTION 3.** That said resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
