A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION CONTINUING INDEFINITELY ITEMS F-12 AND F-13 ON THE AGENDA FROM THE JULY 25, 2022 CITY COMMISSION MEETING TO ALLOW THE APPLICANT AN OPPORTUNITY TO PROPOSE A MODIFIED PROJECT FOR LOTS 8 THROUGH 21, LESS THE WEST ½ OF LOT 8, BLOCK 29, CRAFTS SECTION, TOGETHER WITH THAT PORTION OF THE 20-FOOT PLATTED ALLEY LYING EAST OF LOTS 11 AND 19, OF SAID BLOCK 29 (3000 PONCE DE LEON BLVD., 216 & 224 CATALONIA AVENUE, 203 UNIVERSITY DRIVE, AND 225 MALAGA AVENUE).

WHEREAS, on July 25, 2022 a request was presented to the City Commission for an ordinance amending the Future Land Use Map of the City of Coral Gables Comprehensive Plan (F-12) and an ordinance vacating a public alleyway (F-13) in connection with a new proposed development located at 3000 Ponce de Leon Blvd, 216 & 224 Catalonia Avenue, 203 University Drive and 225 Malaga Avenue; and

WHEREAS, after the public and Commission expressed their concerns about the proposed development, the Commission has asked for the developer to redesign the project for a more appropriate and balanced development that addresses all the concerns that they have articulated; and

WHEREAS, the Commission ask that a new proposal be submitted that more appropriate for the location and which does not mirror what was shown in the previous plans and has significant changes made to it; and

WHEREAS, to that end the majority of the Commissioners (3-2) voted to continue indefinitely items F-12 and F-13;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon the adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission does hereby indefinitely continue F-12 and F-13 from the July 25, 2022 City Commission meeting, until such time that the developer has a new proposal that addresses the concerns of the public and the City Commission.
