**ORDINANCE ON SECOND READING:**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES CODE, CHAPTER 2 “ADMINISTRATION”, ARTICLE VIII “PROCUREMENT CODE”, SECTION 2-696 “PROCEDURE TO PROVIDE PREFERENCE TO CORAL GABLES-BASED VENDORS IN CONTRACTS FOR GOODS AND GENERAL SERVICES” TO ADD A PREFERENCE FOR MIAMI-DADE COUNTY-BASED VENDORS, DEFINE PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS AND EXPAND AND CLARIFY THE PREFERENCE IN COMPETITIVE BIDS , PROVIDING FOR A REPEALER PROVISION, SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, CODIFICATION, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**BRIEF HISTORY:**

The City Code has provided a local preference procedure for Coral Gables-based vendors since 2006. This amendment to the Code expands and clarifies that preference for Miami-Dade County and Coral Gables-based vendors, clarifies the procedures to allow for local vendors to provide best and final bids, and states that such local preference would not be utilized if prohibited by state or federal law, or any other funding entity.

This ordinance was approved on first reading during the October 11, 2022 City Commission meeting and there have been no changes since first reading.
