RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE CHIEF PROCUREMENT OFFICER TO AWARD THE COCOPLUM ENTRY GUARDHOUSE PROJECT TO BEJAR CONSTRUCTION, INC. PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-828 OF THE PROCUREMENT CODE AND INVITATION FOR BID (IFB) 2009.06.20 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$375,000.00 (THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS). PROJECT FUNDED BY COCOPLUM GUARD HOUSE / LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT "CGH-01."

WHEREAS, on June 12, 2009, the Procurement Division of Finance formally advertised, issued and distributed the Cocoplum Entry Guardhouse Invitation for Bid (IFB) 2009.06.20 and,

WHEREAS, on June 18, 2009, a non-mandatory pre-bid conference was held and seven (7) prospective bidders attended of forty-eight (48) prospective bidders who downloaded the bid document from the web-site or picked up the bid document from the Procurement Division of Finance and,

WHEREAS, on July 9, 2009, eleven (11) responses to the IFB were received, submitted by T & G Constructors, Raidan Development, Valley Crest, Merkury Construction, Andes Construction, Bejar Construction, GC Works, Bi-Tech Construction, Wrangler Construction, Trans-America Construction and Wilham & Associates and,

WHEREAS, the lowest responsive responsible bidder for the Cocoplum Entry Guard House Project was Bejar Construction with their bid of \$375,000 (Three Hundred Seventy Five Thousand Dollars) and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

Section 1. That the City of Coral Gables Commission accept the recommendation of the Chief Procurement Officer pursuant to the Invitation for Bid (IFB) No. 2009.06.20 to award the Coco Plum Entry Guard House Project to Bejar Construction, Inc.

Section 2. That all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions inconsistent with, or in conflict herewith, shall be and are hereby repealed insofar as there is conflict or inconsistency.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption herein.
