RESOLUTION 2022-

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE **CHIEF OFFICER PROCUREMENT** TO **AWARD** THE MEDICAL DIRECTOR SERVICES CONTRACT RFP 2021-032 TO INPHYNET SOUTH BROWARD, INC, A RESPONSIVE-RESPONSIBLE PROPOSER, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-763 OF THE PROCUREMENT CODE ENTITLED "CONTRACT AWARD"

WHEREAS, on October 5, 2021, the Procurement Division of Finance formally advertised, issued, and distributed Medical Director Services, Request for Proposals (RFP) 2021-032; and

WHEREAS, on October 19, 2021, a non-mandatory pre-proposal conference was held with four (4) proposers in attendance. Additionally, seventeen (17) prospective proposers downloaded the RFP from Public Purchase, the City's web-based e-Procurement service; and

WHEREAS, on November 4, 2021, one (1) firm submitted a proposal in response to the RFP: InPhyNet South Broward, Inc., and

WHEREAS, on January 28, 2022, the Evaluation Committee convened to evaluate the one (1) responsive and responsible proposal. The Evaluation Committee determined that InPhyNet South Broward, Inc., is a responsive-responsible proposer; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Procurement Officer recommends accepting the Evaluation Committee's recommendation to award and negotiate an agreement with InPhyNet South Broward, Inc., for RFP 2021-035 Medical Director Services; and

WHEREAS Section 2-585 of the Procurement Code authorizes the City Manager to delegate authority to the Chief Procurement Officer to administer and make recommendations on City contracts;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. The City Commission accepts the recommendation of the Procurement Officer to award the Medical Director Services contract RFP 2021-032 to InPhyNet South Broward, Inc., a responsive-responsible proposer, pursuant to Section 2-763 of the Procurement Code entitled "Contract Award", further authorizing the City Manager to negotiate and execute a

Professional Services Agreement, in an amount not to exceed the available budget, for an initial period of three (3) years with options to renew for two (2) additional one (1) year periods, exercisable at the option of the City Manager.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption herein.
