### RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE APPOINTMENTS OF COMMISSIONERS AND STAFF TO SERVE AS MEMBERS OF THE 2024-2025 FLORIDA LEAGUE OF CITIES LEGISLATIVE POLICY COMMITTEES AND AUTHORIZING THOSE COMMISSIONERS AND STAFF MEMBERS TO ADVOCATE FOR THE CITY'S LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES.

**WHEREAS**, the Florida League of Cities (League) is an organization that advocates on behalf of Florida's cities at the state and federal levels and promotes self-governance to help ensure local governments make local choices for their populous; and

**WHEREAS**, the League annually convenes five legislative policy committees (Committees) where representatives from Florida's cities brainstorm ideas and help develop the League's legislative platform for the 2025 Florida legislative session; and

**WHEREAS**, the League appointed the following commissioners and staff to serve as members of the 2024-2025 Committees:

#### Commissioners

1. Vice Mayor Rhonda Anderson – Intergovernmental Relations, Mobility, and Emergency Management
2. Commissioner Ariel Fernandez – Finance and Taxation
3. Commissioner Melissa Castro – Development, Code Compliance, Redevelopment'

#### Staff

4. Chelsea Granell, Mayor's Chief of Staff – Municipal Operations
5. Fernando Weiner, Intergovernmental Affairs Manager – Utilities, Natural Resources, and Public Works

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA:**

**SECTION 1.** That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

**SECTION 2.** That the City Commission hereby accepts the appointments of the aforementioned commissioners and staff to represent the interests of Coral Gables and serve on their assigned Committees.

**SECTION 3.** That the commissioners and staff assigned to the Committees shall put forth and advocate for only those legislative priorities adopted by the City Commission in Resolution 2023-318 as may be amended in any future legislation adopted by the City Commission.

**SECTION 4.** This Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
