DMS-24/25-342 WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT SERVICES UNDER THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CYBERSECURITY GRANT PROGRAM, TO PROVIDE THE CITY WITH TWO CYBERSECURITY SOLUTIONS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE GRANT AGREEMENT FOR SAID ASSISTANCE

BRIEF HISTORY:

The Local Government Cybersecurity Grant Program is a competitive grant initiative that provides local governments with software, services, and solutions designed to enhance their cybersecurity posture, protecting critical infrastructure and data.

In March 2023, the City applied for the grant through the Florida Department of Management Services and received notice of award in May 2025. As part of the award, the City was granted two additional cybersecurity solutions to enhance the City's current security systems and controls.

These platforms will be procured and provided by the Florida Department of Management Services on behalf of the City.
