**RESOLUTION NO. 2017-**

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE AND EXECUTION OF A GRANT FROM THE 2017 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM, TO PURCHASE MOTORCYCLE SADDLEBAG EMERGENCY LIGHTING EQUIPMENT FOR UTILIZATION BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT; AND AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2016-2017 ANNUAL BUDGET TO RECOGNIZE THE \$6,129 GRANT FUNDS AS REVENUE AND TO APPROPRIATE SUCH FUNDS TO COVER THE GRANT EXPENDITURES.

**WHEREAS**, The Coral Gables Police Department is the established local law enforcement agency for the provision of law enforcement services within the jurisdictional boundaries of the City of Coral Gables; and

**WHEREAS**, The Coral Gables Police Department has identified the need to purchase motorcycle saddlebag emergency lighting equipment for utilization by the Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, The State of Florida Department of Law Enforcement awarded the Coral Gables Police Department a 2017 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG-C) in the amount of \$6,129 to purchase motorcycle saddlebag emergency lighting equipment to be used by the Police Department’s Traffic Enforcement Unit; and

**WHEREAS**, an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Annual Budget is required to recognize the \$6,129 grant funds as revenue and to appropriate such funds to cover the cost of the grant expenditures.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:**

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

**SECTION 2.** That the City Commission hereby authorizes the acceptance and execution of the 2017 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG-C) to fund the purchase of motorcycle saddlebag emergency lighting equipment to be used by the Police Department’s Traffic Enforcement Unit.

**SECTION 3.** That the City Commission hereby authorizes an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Annual Budget to recognize the \$6,129 grant funds as revenue and to appropriate such funds to cover the cost of the grant expenditures.

**SECTION 4.** That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
