You, as the Owner and/or Occupant of the premises at:

1125 GREENWAY DR

are in violation of the following sections of the City Code of the City of Coral Gables:

Sec. 58-48. - Duty of abutting property owners to repair
(a) Sidewalks in the city that are broken, cracked or otherwise in such condition as not to present a smooth, continuous surface, are a nuisance. It shall be the duty of the owner of property abutting defective sidewalks to remedy such defective condition. (Code 1958, § 28-13; Code 1991, § 22-47; Code 2006, § 54-81; Ord. No. 791, § 2, 7-21-1953; Ord. No. 2309, § 1, 5-8-1979)

The following steps should be taken to correct the violation:

Remedy: Must remedy defective sidewalks. - Repair/Replace damaged sidewalk; contact building@coralgables.com/305-460-5235 and apply for/obtain all required permits.

As a result of the above violation(s), a complaint has been filed against you and you are hereby commanded to appear before the Code Enforcement Board for a hearing on 1/15/2025 at 08:30 AM in the Commission Chambers, located on the second floor of:

Community Meeting Room 2151 Salzedo Street Coral Gables. FL 33134

This is your notice to appear at said time and place. Failure to do so will result in the matter being heard in absentia. An administrative fee of \$108.75 will be assessed at the time of your hearing.

Please be advised that if someone will be attending the hearing on your behalf, he or she must provide a power of attorney from you at the time of the hearing.

If this notice pertains to failure to maintain a historic structure, please be advised that:

- You may be subject to substantial fines that may not be mitigated
- You may also be required to repair or restore the historic structure.
- If the historic structure is allowed to deteriorate to the point where it must be demolished:
 - The City Code requires that you replace the structure with a similar historically appropriate structure; and
 - The property will no longer qualify for an historic preservation tax exemption
