

**CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA**

**RESOLUTION NO. 2015-291**

**A RESOLUTION TO EXTEND THE PERMITTED DAYTIME CAPACITY FOR AN EVENT AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MIAMI CONVOCATION CENTER (AKA BANK UNITED CENTER) FOR JANUARY 29, 2016; FOR THE INAUGURATION OF JULIO FRENK, UNIVERSITY PRESIDENT.**

**WHEREAS**, Ord. No. 2964 requires that the Convocation Center (aka Bank United Center) attract no more than 1,600 spectators/visitors at a non-academic event scheduled during the academic year between 8 am to 4 pm; and

**WHEREAS**, the University of Miami has requested to exceed the 1,600 spectator/visitor limit by 1,400 persons coming from outside the campus; and

**WHEREAS**, a similar special event was approved by the City Commission on June 8, 2004, for the Dalai Lama's lecture series at the University of Miami Convocation Center (Resolution No. 2004-113);

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:**

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution adoption hereof.


**SECTION 2.** That the City Commission approves the University of Miami's request to exceed the daytime capacity of one thousand six hundred (1,600) spectators/visitors during the academic year between the hours of 8 am and 4 pm, conditioned upon the following: (i) this approval is for an event involving President Frenk's Inauguration; (ii) the said approval is for January 29, 2016; and (iii) the University of Miami will work with City staff on a security, parking and traffic management plan to minimize the impacts on the surrounding neighborhoods.

**SECTION 3.** That the foregoing Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.


