RESOLUTION NO. 2023-106

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2015-17, AS AMENDED, TO REVISE VARIOUS LOCAL BUSINESS TAXES BY THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT, PARKING FEES BY THE PARKING DEPARTMENT, ADMINISTRATIVE FEES BY THE DEVELOPMENT SERVICES DEPARTMENT, AND CERTAIN PARKS FEES BY THE COMMUNITY RECREATION DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that fees for various licenses, permits, and services are necessary to recover the City's cost of providing these services; and

WHEREAS, On October 1, 1995, the state legislature authorized municipalities to increase local business tax rates by a maximum of 5% once every two years as provided for under Chapter 205.0535 of the Florida Statutes. Since the adoption of this legislation, the City of Coral Gables has increased local business tax rates every two years as authorized. The attached Resolution increases each classification by 5% effective for the July 1, 2023, billing of the Fiscal Year 2024 Business Tax Receipts.; and

WHEREAS, based on the Parking System Rate increase schedule, it is necessary to increase the Parking rates of on-street parking rates, surface parking lot rates, garage rates and monthly parking permit rates; and

WHEREAS, the Construction Regulation Board fees need to be updated to cover incremental increases in administrative costs, including investigative costs, attorney's fees and cost of corrective action incurred by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City fees will be updated to account for the administrative costs associated with subsequent requests by property owners to appear before the Construction Regulation Board; and

WHEREAS, the Parks Fee Schedule is based on a five-year fee plan. Due to the increase in operating costs, effective October 1, 2023, non-resident fees will go up by an additional 5% which will result in a change to the current resident and non-resident fee differential from 25% to 30%. Exception to this are the Tennis membership fees, which due to limited capacity and benchmarking of other tennis centers will increase by 10% for both the resident and non-resident fees. Additional corrections to fees of the Phase 1 preliminary Country Club structure were done to include a couples membership rate, price increases for future years as well as corrections to venue rates from daytime and evening rates to a daily rate. The amended fees will continue to

follow the existing fee plan and increase by 5% every other year. Exceptions to this are contractor programs that are dependent of costs of the program to set fees and destination locations that may see greater increases. This greater increase is due to increased demand or the value of the activity in accordance with the fee charged;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. The City Commission revises the Fee Schedule as detailed in Exhibit I, with changes indicated by <u>underline</u> for new text and strikethrough for deleted text.

SECTION 3. If any section, sentence, clause of phrase of this Resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution.

SECTION 4. That said Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.

Cost Recovery

In addition to the fees contemplated herein, an administrative fee for the various costs incurred by the City in conferring with professionals and/or consultants to enable the City's review of applications is hereby imposed. Said fee shall be equal to the City's actual costs related to the use of consultants and/or professionals in reviewing the application. These costs shall include, but not be limited to, costs for engineering, traffic, design, legal, and other consultants and/or professionals deemed necessary by the City for the proper and complete review and evaluation of the application.

Applicants shall be required to deposit said fees into an account, to be established by the City, when deemed appropriate by the Development Services Director, Public Works Director, City Attorney, or its Designee. Deposited funds will be utilized for payment of consultant and/or professional fees incurred during application review.

Applicants shall reimburse the city for such costs within five days of the date of receipt of an invoice for such services. Failure by applicants to make such reimbursement when due may stay the pending application until paid.

- 1. The application fees above do not include additional processing fees such as advertising fees and public hearing notification fees. These are additional fees.
- 2. Separate applications are subject to each application fee.
- 3. Requires filing of site plan application and associated fees.

Posting of Bond

Before any permit authorized herein shall be issued, the owner of the property or his contractor shall deposit with the city that amount which in the opinion of the Building Official and/or City Manager shall be adequate to reimburse the city, or any neighboring property owner, for damage which may result to sidewalks, parkways, parkway trees and shrubs, street pavements or other municipal or private property, or improvement from such work and the equipment and materials used in connection therewith, and for the removal of debris or excess material upon the completion of said work, and any administrative costs, and shall sign an undertaking to the city to pay the amount of any deficiency between the amount of said deposit and the cost of repairing any such damage or removal of any such debris or excess materials and any administrative costs. Upon completion of the work, the depositor shall request that the Building Official, or such other person as may be designated by the City Manager, make final inspection for the purpose of releasing the bond and if the Building Official, or such other person as may be designated by the City Manager finds that no such damage has resulted, and no debris of material remains on the site, or administrative costs accrued, the said deposit shall be returned to the depositor, or, if any damage shall be repaired by the city, or any debris or excess material be removed or any administrative costs accrued by the city, and the cost thereof shall be less than the deposit, then the difference between such cost and the amount of the deposit shall be returned to the depositor.
