I would like to nominate Officer Lakaevia Tyler for the "Officer of the Month" award. On Friday, November 12, 2021, at approximately 08:46 hours, an in-progress theft of a bicycle from 1171 Campo Sano Avenue was dispatched. Multiple units responded to the area in reference to the BOLO of a black male wearing a black hoodie and black pants on a blue mountain bicycle, last seen heading northbound through the Riviera Golf Course toward Blue Road. Officer Lakaevia Tyler responded to the area and saw a black male fitting the description on the 900-Blk. of Roderigo Avenue. Officer Tyler advised dispatch she was behind the possible subject and was instructed to provide updates as she followed him. Officer Tyler kept updating dispatch of her location as she followed the subject. The subject proceeded to head south on Durango Street and then northbound on Granada Boulevard. Officer Tyler awaited for her back up to detain the subject and he was eventually blocked in at the 3900-Blk. of Granada Boulevard by Officer Tyler and Officer James Coleman.

A show-up was conducted on scene with the victim of the bicycle theft, who positively identified her stolen bicycle and positively identified the male subject who had entered her yard to steal the bicycle. The subject had just fled from the security guard at Baptist Hospital after he had contacted the Coral Gables Police Department to issue him a Trespass Warning (21-006473). The subject was seen in the parking garage acting suspicious and was unable to deter the security's guard concern after he approached him. The subject left another bicycle behind in the parking garage after fleeing from the security guard. The bicycle left behind by the subject was impounded to the Coral Gables Police Department after an NCIC/FCIC check came back with negative results. Officer Tyler's great observation skills removed another subject off the street, preventing any further thefts in the city. In the last month the City of Coral Gables has had an uptick of bicycle thefts and Officer Tyler's intervention and arrest (21-006472) of the subject will contribute to curtail the increase in bicycle thefts we have had in the city. Officer Tyler is deserving of this award.

NARRATIVE

On November 11, 2021, I was dispatched to 5000 University Dr, in reference to a trespass warning involving a black male, wearing a black shirt, black shorts, and green backpack.

Contact was made with the Director of Security of Doctor's Hospital Mr. Alex Garabedian (Reporting Party), who advised he made contact with Mr. Malik Frazier (Involved Other), at approximately 0715 hours, on the 6th floor of the Doctor's Hospital Parking Lot, charging his phone. He advised Mr. Frazier stated that he was there waiting for someone staying at the ER. However, when he said the name of the patient and Mr. Garabedian checked, there was no one under that name in the ER. Mr. Garabedian stated that when he made contact with Mr. Frazier, he had a red/white bicycle. Mr. Frazier left the bicycle in the garage and went west bound on Campo Sano Ave, towards 1171 Campo Sano Av. The bicycle was impounded into CGPD Property.

A few moments later, at approximately 0848 hours, another call for service involving a theft of a bicycle with a suspect matching Mr. Frazier's description was initiated.

CGPD units observed a male matching Mr. Frazier's description traveling northbound on the 3900 BLK of Granada Blvd. Mr. Frazier was positively identified and was taken into CGPD custody reference Case #21-006472.

Mr. Garabedian issued a trespass warning to Mr. Frazier in my presence.

Narrative:

On Friday, November 12, 2021, at 0847 hours, CGPD responded to 1171 Campo Sano Avenue reference her bicycle that was stolen. Upon arrival, CGPD made contact with Ms. Tania Garrido (witness), who stated that while she was eating breakfast in her kitchen, she observed Mr. Malik Frazier (offender) enter the rear porch of her residence at approximately 0845. Mr. Frazier removed her blue Mercurio Ranger Mountain Bicycle, valued at approximately \$200.00, from the rear porch of her residence. Ms. Garrido described Mr. Frazier as a black male, wearing a black hooded sweater, black pants and a black backpack. Ms. Garrido stated that the bicycle was unsecured and positioned next to the sliding glass door on the outside on the porch, with the kick stand down. Ms. Garrido stated that she observed Mr. Frazier get on the bike, at which point she opened the glass sliding door and yelled for Mr. Frazier to stop. Ms. Garrido stated that as she began calling CGPD, she observed Mr. Frazier ride across Rivera golf course on the bicycle and then she eventually lost sight of him.

Shortly after, I located Mr. Frazier riding the blue Mercurio Mountain Bicycle traveling northbound on the 3900-Blk of Granada Blvd. Mr. Frazier was given several verbal commands to stop and get off the bicycle. Mr. Frazier acknowledged me but refused to follow my commands. CGPD emergency equipment was activated, and Mr. Frazier proceeded to make a right turn on Algaringo avenue, a left on Toledo street, a left on Andres avenue, a left on Durango street, then a right on Algaringo avenue. Mr. Frazier then made a left to proceed southbound back onto Granada Boulevard. At which point, Mr. Frazier was blocked and stopped by myself and Officer Coleman at the 3900-blk of Granada Boulevard. Mr. Frazier was then placed into custody.

A show-up was conducted on scene at the 3900-BLK Granada at 0931, resulting in a positive identification from the victim, of the offender and her blue Mercurio Mountain Bicycle. Following that, Mr. Frazier was placed under arrest and transported to CGPD for processing then to TGK for booking.

Crime Scene Tech Sierra (9298) responded to the scene of the burglary and to CGPD reference photographs.

BLACK PANTS AND A BLACK BACKPACK. WITNESS STATED THAT THE BICYCLE WAS UNSECURED AND POSITIONED NEXT TO THE SLIDING GLASS DOOR ON THE OUTSIDE ON THE PORCH, WITH THE KICK STAND DOWN. THE WITNESS STATED THAT SHE OBSERVED THE DEFENDANT GET ON THE BIKE, AT WHICH POINT SHE OPENED THE GLASS SLIDING DOOR AND YELLED FOR THE DEFENDANT TO STOP. WITNESS STATED THAT AS SHE BEGAN CALLING CGPD, SHE OBSERVED THE DEFENDANT RIDE ACROSS RIVERA GOLF COURSE ON THE BICYCLE AND THEN SHE LOST SIGHT OF HIM. SHORTLY AFTER, I LOCATED THE DEFENDANT, MATCHING THE DESCRIPTION, AND RIDING THE BLUE MERCURIO MOUNTAIN BICYCLE TRAVELING SOUTHBOUND ON THE 3900-BLK OF GRANADA BLVD. DEFENDANT WAS GIVEN SEVERAL VERBAL COMMANDS TO STOP AND GET OFF THE BICYCLE. DEFENDANT ACKNOWLEDGED CGPD BUT REFUSED TO STOP AT THAT MOMENT. CGPD EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT WAS ACTIVATED AND THE DEFENDANT PROCEEDED TO MAKE A RIGHT TURN ON ALGARINGO AVENUE, A LEFT ON TOLEDO STREET, A LEFT ON ANDRES AVENUE, A LEFT ON DURANGO STREET, THEN A RIGHT ON ALGARINGO AVENUE. THE DEFENDANT THEN MADE A LEFT BACK ONTO GRANADA BOULEVARD AT WHICH POINT, HE WAS BLOCK AND STOPPED BY OFFICER COLEMAN AT THE 3900-BLK OF GRANADA BOULEVARD. DEFENDANT WAS THEN PLACED INTO CUSTODY. A SHOW-UP WAS CONDUCTED ON SCENE AT THE 3900-BLK GRANADA AT 0931 RESULTING IN A POSITIVE IDENTIFICATION FROM THE VICTIM OF THE DEFENDANT AND BLUE MERCURIO MOUNTAIN BICYCLE. FOLLOWING THAT, DEFENDANT WAS PLACED UNDER ARREST AND TRANSPORTED TO CGPD FOR PROCESSING THEN TO TKG FOR BOOKING.
