ITEM TITLE:

Ordinance on First Reading. City Code Text Amendment.

An Ordinance of the City of Coral Gables, Florida, amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Coral Gables by amending Chapter 6, Section 6-4, "Administrative review by city manager with approval by city commission for retail beverage and retail liquor store licenses issued to nonrestaurant facilities" to permit open air seating for nonrestaurant facilities that have obtained approval to sell alcoholic beverages; providing for a repealer provision, severability clause, codification, and providing for an effective date.

DEPARTMENT HEAD RECOMMENDATION:

BRIEF HISTORY:

As directed by the City Commission, Staff has prepared text amendments to the City Code to allow non-restaurant facilities to apply for open air seating on the sidewalk fronting Miracle Mile and Giralda Plaza and on private property within the Business Improvement District (BID).

At the December 10, 2019, City Commission meeting, the Commission discussed the current approval process and directed Staff to prepare text amendments to not require mailed notices and public information meetings for non-restaurant facilities requesting open air seating.
