ITEM TITLE:

Resolution. A Resolution of the City Commission of Coral Gables, Florida supporting the Resolution of the International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP) opposing the sale of armor-piercing and tracer ammunition. (Sponsored by Vice Mayor Keon)

BRIEF HISTORY:

The City of Coral Gables received communications from the International Association of Chiefs of Police (“IACP”) on pending legislative items and indicating the IACP’s stance on the policies being set forth by said legislation. Included with the communications is the IACP’s opposition of the sale of armor-piercing and tracer ammunition.

The IACP opposes H.R. 3668 and supports legislation and policies that will prohibit the sale or transfer of armor piercing ammunition. The IACP believes that current federal law should be modified to establish that the process utilized to determine whether a round of ammunition is armor piercing should include performance based testing conducted by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms.

This Resolution declares the City of Coral Gables’ support of the IACP’s stance opposing the sale of armor-piercing and tracer ammunition.
