RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A DAY LONG EXHIBITION  
AT CITY HALL OF A MURAL ENTITLED "MADRIA TIRI"  
BY CUNDO BERMUDEZ AS PART OF THE GABLES  
HISPANIC CULTURAL FESTIVAL ON SEPTEMBER 25,  
2010.

**WHEREAS**, The Gables Hispanic Cultural Festival and the Estate of Cundo Bermudez have requested the ability to display the mural entitled "Madria Tiri" in the first floor hallway of City Hall during the festival hours of 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Saturday, September 25, 2010; and

**WHEREAS**, the Gables Hispanic Cultural Festival, at its cost, will provide a security guard during the time that City Hall is open, will not open the bathrooms in City Hall to the public, and will ensure that there is access down the stairs to an exit door; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cultural Development Board recommended approval of this request in its Board meeting on August 31, 2010;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA:**

**SECTION 1.** That the foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon the adoption hereof.

**SECTION 2.** That the City Commission does hereby authorize the City Manager to accept the recommendation of the Cultural Development Board to allow the Gables Hispanic Cultural Festival and Estate of Cundo Bermudez to present a day long exhibition of the mural "Madria Tiri" on the first floor of City Hall under the conditions presented above in the "Whereas" clauses.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
