Resolution accepting the Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) Grant Program Memorandum of Agreement between the City of Miami and the City of Coral Gables; and authorizing an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2015-2016 Annual Budget to recognize the grant as revenue and to appropriate such funds to cover the grant expenditures.

Mayor Cason: Are we ready for H-2?

City Manager Swanson-Rivenbark: Yes we are sir. The City of Miami is the recipient of an urban area security initiative through Homeland Security, and they have the ability to enter into agreements with other cities for grants. This is \$63,500 grant for Homeland Security initiatives. It involves the purchase of monitors, video wall and computer hardware related to our emergency operation center on the fourth floor. If you approve this we would revise our 2015-2016 Budget to reflect this new revenue. We would also then enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the City of Miami to receive these funds and use it for those purposes.
