CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA RESOLUTION NO. 2019-___

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2015-101, TO AMEND THE PURPOSE OF THE BOARD; THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE UPON THE DATE OF ITS ADOPTION.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 30149, passed and adopted by the City Commission on August 28, 2001 2011, established a citywide Traffic Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2005-17, passed and adopted by the City Commission on January 25, 2005, broadened the City's Traffic Advisory Board's purpose to include serving as an Oversight Committee for transportation related projects; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2015-101 passed and adopted by the City Commission on June 16, 2015, renamed the Traffic Advisory Board, decreased membership, and broadened the board's purpose to include various transportation modes; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to further define the purpose of the Board, the City Commission wishes to amend the past resolutions to include that the Board may recommend policies and strategies to apply in all City neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to further define the ultimate goal of the Board, the City Commission wishes to amend the past resolutions to include the efficient use of all roads, streets, avenues, boulevards, alleyways and any and all other public rights of way;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. That the foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That Resolution 2015-101 is hereby amended as follows:

 <u>PURPOSE</u>. That the purpose of the Board shall be to identify and recommend improvements to develop transportation connectivity of all modes to provide a variety of transportation alternatives. One of the primary objectives of this Board would be to maintain a well-integrated urban street grid, providing access to commercial centers without sacrificing the high quality of life that exists within city neighborhoods. It will review traffic calming opportunities and recommend policies <u>and strategies</u> to apply in <u>all</u> City neighborhoods. The ultimate goal would be to effectively protect and maintain the multi-modal transportation network and the safe, effective, and efficient use of all roads, streets, avenues, boulevards, alleyways and any and all other public rights of way.

SECTION 3. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution.

SECTION 4. That said Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
