RESOLUTION NO. 2010-49

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES AND MIAMI-DADE COUNTY STIPULATING THE ENFORCEMENT OF THE COUNTY-WIDE ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO MULTI-FAMILY AND COMMERCIAL RECYCLING WITHIN THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, the requirement for multi-family and commercial recycling is a Miami-Dade County Code mandate for all of Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coral Gables is supportive of the goals of a multi-family and commercial recycling program; and

WHEREAS, the enforcement of the recycling requirements by the City of Coral Gables would require additional funding that is unavailable at this time;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. That the foregoing "whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That a memorandum of understanding between the City and the County is hereby authorized to be executed, which stipulates that the County shall enforce Sections 15-2.2, 15-2.3 and 15-2.4 of the Miami-Dade County Code.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
