A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$187,615 FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION (FDEP) RESILIENT FLORIDA PROGRAM OFFICE OF RESILIENCE AND COASTAL PROTECTION FOR AN UPDATED **CITYWIDE** VULNERABILITY ASSESSMENT AND ADAPTATION PLAN: AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF THE GRANT CONTRACT; AND AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 ANNUAL BUDGET TO RECOGNIZE THE \$187,615 GRANT AS REVENUE AND TO APPROPRIATE SUCH FUNDS TO PUT TOWARD THE COST OF THE PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City of Coral Gables was awarded a grant for the purpose to update the Vulnerability Assessment and Adaptation Plan, The previous Vulnerability Assessment Plan was completed in 2018; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this program is to identify flood vulnerabilities by conducting exposure and sensitive analyses citywide that will include reports, maps and tables presenting results in a standardized form to align with the requirements of S.3803093, F. S Resilient Florida Grant; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coral Gables will implement the grant funded initiative in accordance with all requirements provide by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection Resilient Florida Program; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Annual Budget is required to recognize the \$187,615 grant as revenue, and to appropriate such funds to put toward the cost of the project; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends the Commission authorizes annual budget amendments, as needed, for the life of the program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA THAT:

- **SECTION 1.** That the forgoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption herein.
- **SECTION 2.** That the City Commission does hereby authorize the acceptance of the grant in the amount of \$187,615 towards the Citywide Vulnerability Assessment Plan.

SECTION 3. That the City Commission does hereby authorize the execution of the grant contract with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection.

SECTION 4. That the City Commission does hereby authorize an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 annual budget to recognize the \$187,615 grant as revenue, and to appropriate such funds to put toward the cost of the project.

SECTION 5. That the City Commission does hereby authorize any required future budget amendments, as needed, for the life of the program.

SECTION 6. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
