SUBJECT: Resolution calling special

elections in the proposed Gables by the Sea-Coral Gables Security Guard Special Taxing District located entirely within the boundaries of the City of Coral Gables, and bounded on the north by Cartagena Avenue, on the east by Biscayne Bay, on the south by Bella Vista Avenue, and on the west by Old Cutler Road; and the proposed Gables by the Sea-Pinecrest Security Guard Special Taxing District located entirely within the boundaries of the Village of Pinecrest generally bounded on the north by Lugo Avenue, on the east by SW 57 Avenue, on the south by SW 136 Street, and on the west by Old Cutler Road, for the purpose of submitting to qualified electors residing in each of the proposed special taxing districts the question of whether the existing Gables by the Sea Security Guard Special Taxing District shall be abolished and replaced with two proposed new special taxing districts, one within the boundaries of the City of Coral Gables and one within the boundaries of the Village of Pinecrest, and transferring each new special taxing district to its respective municipality such that each municipality would be the governing body of a new special taxing district

RESOLUTION NO. R-895-22

RESOLUTION CALLING SPECIAL ELECTIONS IN THE PROPOSED GABLES BY THE SEA-CORAL SECURITY GUARD SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICT LOCATED ENTIRELY WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES, AND BOUNDED ON THE NORTH BY CARTAGENA AVENUE, ON THE EAST BY BISCAYNE BAY, ON THE SOUTH BY BELLA VISTA AVENUE, AND ON THE WEST BY OLD CUTLER ROAD; AND THE PROPOSED GABLES BY THE SEA-PINECREST SECURITY GUARD SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICT LOCATED ENTIRELY WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE VILLAGE OF PINECREST GENERALLY BOUNDED ON THE NORTH BY LUGO AVENUE, ON THE EAST BY SW 57 AVENUE, ON THE SOUTH BY SW 136 STREET, AND ON THE WEST BY OLD CUTLER ROAD, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO QUALIFIED ELECTORS RESIDING IN EACH OF THE PROPOSED SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICTS THE QUESTION OF WHETHER THE EXISTING GABLES BY THE SEA SECURITY GUARD SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICT SHALL BE ABOLISHED AND REPLACED WITH TWO PROPOSED NEW **SPECIAL** TAXING DISTRICTS, **ONE** WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES AND ONE THE BOUNDARIES OF THE VILLAGE OF PINECREST, AND TRANSFERRING EACH NEW SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICT TO ITS RESPECTIVE MUNICIPALITY SUCH THAT EACH MUNICIPALITY WOULD BE THE GOVERNING BODY OF A NEW SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICT

WHEREAS, on October 6, 2022 , this Board passed Ordinance No. 22-122, which subject to approval of the qualified electors, will abolish the Gables by the Sea Security Guard Special Taxing District, and create two separate security guard special taxing districts, one within the boundaries of the City of Coral Gables to be known as Gables by the Sea-Coral Gables Security Guard Special Taxing District, and one within the boundaries of the Village of Pinecrest to be known as Gables by the Sea-Pinecrest Security Guard Special Taxing District ("Special Taxing Districts"); and

WHEREAS, this Board passed Resolution No.R-896-22, which, if approved by the qualified electors, will transfer these new special taxing districts to their respective municipalities; and

WHEREAS, section 18-3(f) of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida ("Code") provides that an ordinance creating and establishing a special taxing district shall take effect when approved by a majority vote of the qualified electors residing in the new special taxing district voting at an election called by the Board and noticed and conducted in such manner as this Board shall determine by resolution; and

WHEREAS, section 1.01 of the Home Rule Charter provides that the governing body of a municipality may be the governing body of a special taxing district located entirely within the municipality if the municipality assumes any and all liabilities of the special taxing district; and

WHEREAS, section 18-3.1 of the Code as amended, presently provides that a resolution approving the transfer of such a special taxing district shall take effect when approved by a majority vote of the qualified electors residing in the special taxing district voting at an election to be called by the Board and noticed and conducted in such manner as the Board shall by resolution determine,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. In accordance with the provisions of section 18-3(f) and section 18-3.1 of the Code, special elections are hereby called and shall be held within the boundaries of the proposed Gables by the Sea-Coral Gables Security Guard Special Taxing District, and the proposed Gables by the Sea-Pinecrest Security Guard Special Taxing District, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors residing in each proposed special taxing district, for their approval or disapproval, the abolishment of the Gables by the Sea Security Guard Special Taxing District, and the creation and transfer of the proposed special taxing districts as provided in, Ordinance No. 22-122 and Resolution No. R-896-22 respectively:

ORDINANCE ABOLISHING A SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICT IN FLORIDA, MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, WITHIN BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES AND THE VILLAGE OF PINECREST, GENERALLY BOUNDED ON THE NORTH BY CARTAGENA AND LUGO AVENUES, ON THE EAST BY BISCAYNE BAY, ON THE SOUTH BY SW 136 STREET AND BY BELLA VISTA AVENUE, AND ON THE WEST BY OLD CUTLER ROAD, KNOWN AND DESCRIBED AS GABLES BY THE SEA SECURITY GUARD SPECIAL TAXING **SERVICES** DISTRICT: ABOLISHING THEREIN: CREATING A SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICT WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF CORAL **GABLES** GENERALLY BOUNDED ON THE NORTH BY CARTAGENA AVENUE, ON THE EAST BY BISCAYNE BAY, ON THE SOUTH BY BELLA VISTA AVENUE, AND ON THE WEST BY OLD CUTLER ROAD, KNOWN AND DESCRIBED AS GABLES BY THE SEA-CORAL GABLES SECURITY GUARD SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICT: AND CREATING A SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICT WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE VILLAGE OF PINECREST GENERALLY BOUNDED ON THE NORTH BY LUGO AVENUE, ON THE EAST BY SW 57 AVENUE, ON THE SOUTH BY SW 136 STREET, AND ON THE WEST BY OLD CUTLER ROAD, KNOWN AND DESCRIBED AS GABLES BY THE SEA-PINECREST SECURITY GUARD SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICT: SUBJECT TO APPROVAL BY QUALIFIED ELECTORS IN EACH DISTRICT FOR THE CREATION AND TRANSFER OF BOTH DISTRICTS TO THE MUNICIPALITIES; AND PROVIDING FOR EXCLUSION FROM THE CODE AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE GABLES BY THE SEA-CORAL GABLES SECURITY GUARD SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICT LOCATED ENTIRELY WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES, AND BOUNDED ON THE NORTH BY CARTAGENA AVENUE, ON THE EAST BY BISCAYNE BAY, ON THE SOUTH BY BELLA VISTA AVENUE, AND ON THE WEST BY OLD CUTLER ROAD, AND THE GABLES BY THE SEA-PINECREST SECURITY GUARD SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICT LOCATED ENTIRELY WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE VILLAGE OF PINECREST GENERALLY BOUNDED ON THE NORTH BY LUGO AVENUE, ON THE EAST BY SW 57 AVENUE, ON THE SOUTH BY SW 136 STREET, AND ON THE WEST BY OLD CUTLER ROAD; TRANSFERRING EACH SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICT TO ITS RESPECTIVE MUNICIPALITY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 18-3.1 OF THE CODE OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH EACH MUNICIPALITY FOR THE TRANSFERS; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE SAME

Section 2. Notice of such special elections shall be published in accordance with section 100.342, Florida Statutes.

Section 3. The results of such special elections shall be determined by a majority of the qualified electors residing in each proposed new special taxing district voting at such special elections. All qualified electors residing in each of the proposed new special taxing districts shall be entitled to vote at said special elections.

Section 4. The County registration books shall remain open at the Office of the Miami-Dade County Supervisor of Elections until November 14, 2022, at which date the registration books shall close in accordance with the provisions of the general election laws.

Section 5. Mailed ballots, as prescribed by the Code, shall be used in these special elections. The Supervisor of Elections shall cause such ballots to be sent by mail to all qualified electors residing in each of the proposed new special taxing districts, at least ten calendar days prior to the date of said special elections.

Section 6. The special elections shall be held on December 13, 2022. All marked ballots must be received by 7:00 p.m. on the day of said elections.

<u>Section 7.</u> The question which shall appear on the ballot for the qualified electors within the proposed Gables by the Sea-Coral Gables Security Guard Special Taxing District shall be in substantially the following form:

The County Mayor or County Mayor's designee, the Finance Director, the Supervisor of Elections, and the Clerk of the County Commission are hereby authorized and directed to take all appropriate actions necessary to carry into effect and accomplish the provisions of this resolution.

Section 10. The special elections shall be canvassed by the County Canvassing Board as provided under the election laws of this State, in accordance with the provisions of section 3.07 of the Home Rule Charter.
