RESOLUTION NO: 2010-101

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE AND EXECUTION OF A GRANT AWARD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$11,752.00, FROM THE EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM FY 2010, TO FUND THE CORAL GABLES PROJECT RETURN TO ASSIST RESIDENTS AT RISK OF WANDERING.

WHEREAS, The Coral Gables Police Department is the established local law enforcement agency for the provision of law enforcement services within the jurisdictional boundaries of the City of Coral Gables; and

WHEREAS, The United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance, has awarded funding to the Coral Gables Police Department; and

WHEREAS, The Coral Gables Police Department has identified the need to develop a program for residents at risk of wandering to assist with the search for wandering or lost individuals with Alzheimer's, Autism, or other cognitive medical conditions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission does hereby authorize the acceptance and execution of the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant FY 2010, to fund the Coral Gables Project Return to assist residents at risk of wandering in the amount of \$11,752.00.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
