Sole Source Justification	Symphony dispatch console, which is in use at the current Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP), or E911 center. Symphony consoles are also in operation at our Backup PSAP. Our E911 center personnel are trained and familiar with the current equipment as is our Radio Shop personnel as it relates to technical support. There is already a supply of spare parts to support Symphony consoles. The P25 system will not support another console from a different vendor without a Console Sub System Interface (CSSI), which the City does not currently have. Further, the City utilizes encryption to facilitate communications security. This encryption utilizes keys, which are deployed and, changed, remotely utilizing Over The Air R ekeying (OTAR). L3Harris and Motorola Solutions are the only two vendors capable of supplying equipment that can utilize OTAR signaling for encryption keys. Utilizing Motorola Solutions consoles would necessitate retraining all communications operators and, radio shop personnel and, the purchase of CSSI. Further, since these are additional consoles, it would create a mixture of vendors and equipment in the E911 center. Communications International is the City's assigned L3Harris dealer.
