RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE CHIEF PROCUREMENT OFFICER TO EXTEND THE TROLLEY OPERATIONS CONTRACT WITH FIRST TRANSIT, INC., PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-829 OF THE PROCUREMENT CODE ENTITLED "APPROVAL OF CHANGE ORDERS AND CONTRACT MODIFICATIONS" FROM FEBRUARY 20, 2012, ON A MONTH-TO-MONTH BASIS FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED THREE (3) MONTHS TO PROVIDE TIME FOR A NEW TROLLEY OPERATIONS CONTRACT TO BE EXECUTED.

WHEREAS, on September 12, 2006, the City Commission approved a three (3) year contract with First Transit, Inc., to provide trolley operation services, which provided for a negotiated extension for an additional two (2) years; and

WHEREAS, on October 27, 2009, this contract was extended based on a negotiated extension until November 20, 2011; and

WHEREAS, on October 11, 2011, the City Commission approved an extension of this contract to provide time to solicit proposals and to execute and new contract; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Procurement Officer recommends that the current contract be extended from February 20, 2012, on a month-to-month basis for a period not to exceed three (3) months to provide additional time for the Request for Proposal (RFP) process to be completed and for a new contract to be approved and executed; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-650 of the Procurement Code authorizes the City Manager to delegate authority to the Chief Procurement Officer to administer and make recommendations on City contracts; and

WHEREAS, the Trolley Operations Contract with First Transit, Inc., may be extended under Section 2-829 of the Procurement Code entitled "Approval of Change Orders and Contract Modifications."

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission accepts the recommendation of the Chief Procurement Officer authorizing an extension of the Trolley Operations Contract with First Transit, Inc., pursuant to Section 2-829 of the Procurement Code entitled "Approval of Change Orders and Contract Modifications" from February 20, 2012, on a month-to-month basis for a

period not to exceed three (3) months to provide additional time for the Request for Proposal (RFP) process to be completed and for a new contract to be approved and executed.

SECTION 3. That all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions inconsistent with, or in conflict herewith, shall be and are hereby repealed insofar as there is conflict or inconsistency.

SECTION 4. This resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption herein.
