RESOLUTION NO. 2009-263

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY PLACEMENT OF FIVE (5) 3' X 3 1/2' BANNERS AT CERTAIN CITY FACILITIES FROM OCTOBER 23 THROUGH OCTOBER 31, 2009, IN RECOGNITION OF "RED RIBBON CAMPAIGN WEEK" IN THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES.

WHEREAS, the Red Ribbon week is scheduled this year for the week of October 23, 2009 through October 31, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Red Ribbon Campaign has a tradition of displaying red ribbons as a symbol of intolerance towards the use of drugs; and

WHEREAS, the Red Ribbon week is a way for communities to take a visible stand against drugs through the symbol of the Red Ribbon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption herein.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission does hereby approve a temporarily display of five (5) 3' x 3 1/2' banners in recognition of this important event, "Red Ribbon Campaign Week", at the Coral Gables Youth Center, Central Police and Fire Station, Fire Station No. 2, Fire Station No. 3, and the Maintenance and Storage Facility.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
