A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION ESTABLISHING A PROTOCOL FOR HONORING MEMBERS AND FORMER MEMBERS OF THE CITY COMMISSION WHO HAVE PERISHED. (Sponsored by Commissioner Fernandez)

BRIEF HISTORY:

The City Commission seeks to establish a protocol to honor the City's elected officials once they are deceased. This protocol should both recognize the service rendered by the individual to their community and provide an opportunity for friends and loved ones to pay their respects within City Hall, the actual and symbolic monument of civic life within Coral Gables. To that end, the City Commission directs that when a past or present City elected official has passed away, a portrait of that person will be displayed for a one-week period outside of the City Commission offices and a condolence book will be made available for the public to sign.
