

CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA

A RESOLUTION OF THE WATERWAY ADVISORY BOARD REQUESTING THE CITY COMMISSION, THROUGH THE CITY MANAGER, TO DIRECT THE DEVELOPMENT SERVICES DEPARTMENT (CODE ENFORCEMENT), AND POLICE DEPARTMENT (MARINE PATROL) TO PROVIDE MONTHLY SUMMARY REPORTS REFLECTING WATERWAY RELATED ACTIVITIES AND CITATIONS ISSUED TO WATERFRONT PROPERTY OWNERS AND THEIR STATUS.

WHEREAS, the Waterway Advisory Board (Board) has an interest in the maintenance and welfare of Coral Gables waterways; and

WHEREAS, the Board is seeking action from the City Commission through City Manager to direct the Development Services Department (Code Enforcement) and Police Department (Marine Patrol), to provide monthly summary reports reflecting citations issued to waterfront property owners and their status; and

WHEREAS, this will assist the Board identify problem areas for future monitoring and recommendations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. The Waterway Advisory Board is requesting the City Commission, through the City Manager, to direct the Development Services Department (Code Enforcement) and Police Department (Marine Patrol) to provide monthly summary reports reflecting waterway related activities and citations issued to waterfront property owners and their status.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
