The following represents a summary of the items discussed during the Committee meeting.

-MEETING AGENDA -

I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 8:30am.

II. ROLL CALL

A quorum was present. Approval of minutes postponed until next meeting.

III. OLD BUSINESS

- a. West Lab Expansion Issue Update & Review.
 - Naomi provides update on the Mayor's meeting with the Superintendent and the positive outlook for the West Lab issue.
 - Construction has restarted at West Lab and the commission should be taking up the item soon.
 - Ariel expresses a desire to have another community meeting regarding the purchasing of seats at West Lab.
 - The group discusses the possibility of a facebook live town hall or question and answer session, possibly supported by Moms Rising organization.
- b. October Board Meeting Items Review
 - Sam recommends board members attend or watch school board meetings if they can.
 - Board item regarding boundary seats in magnet programs.
 - Sibling preference broadened (older & younger).
 - In order to meet definition of magnet school at least 25% of students must be from "out of boundary".
 - All students must meet Magnet School criteria in terms of academics etc.
 - If there is space students can enroll regardless of magnet school deadlines.
 - Instead of guaranteeing boundary students admission they receive priority.
 - School Calendar post hurricane:
 - Elementary and Secondary calendar: January 19th, February 15th, April 19th, May 17th are the now regular school days.
 - Board item proffered by Mari Tere allowed superintendent to communicate with Florida Commissioner of Education Pam Stuart to obtain and negotiate relief from the State.
 - MDCPS is getting an influx of students from the US Virgin Islands and Puerto Rico; need to try to move funding data back to account for new students.
