The National Community Survey™ in Coral Gables




The NCS™ for Coral Gables, FL

- 2nd time conducting The NCS (previous survey in 2021)
- Survey conducted from September 13, 2023

 October 23, 2023.
- Mailing approach employed:
 - Probability-based sample of 3,000 randomly selected households
 - 452 total responses received
 - 16% overall response rate
 - Non-probability, open-participation survey: 75 responses
- Results statistically weighted to reflect Coral Gables overall
- 95% confidence interval with a +/- 5% margin of error






Facets of Community Livability: Quality






Facets of Community Livability: Importance










Comparisons to National Benchmarks








Comparisons to Peer Community Benchmarks

Key Findings






Scores for mobility in Coral **Gables generally** remain stable, with some improvements observed since the previous survey.

*All higher to national and peer benchmarks




Residents continue to enjoy a high quality of life and strong sense of safety in their community.



Overall Community Quality







The overall quality of life in Coral Gables, 2023











Coral Gables' economy remains strong.



The Economy in Coral Gables




Overall economic health of Coral Gables, 2023

- 26% very or somewhat positive






Many aspects of the **Coral Gables'** community design receive positive reviews, but residents identify some potential areas of opportunity for the city.



Community Design in Coral Gables




Overall design or layout of Coral Gables's residential and commercial areas, 2023
