**A RESOLUTION OF THE TRANSPORTATION
ADVISORY BOARD RECOMMENDING APPROVAL
OF THE ROUNDABOUT ON CORAL WAY AND
ANDERSON**

WHEREAS, on February 27, 2018, a Resolution was passed by the City Commission adopting the City of Coral Gables Sustainable Complete Streets Policy; and

WHEREAS, on April 24, 2018, Article 8, Section 8-104 (D) of the Coral Gables Zoning Code was amended by the City Commission to allow for the designation of the city plan as historic; and

WHEREAS, on June 21, 2018, the Coral Gables Historic City Plan was designated as a local historic landmark; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County submitted an application requesting to modify the historic street grid and introduce a vehicular roundabout at Coral Way and Anderson; and

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2023, the Historic Preservation Board recommended denial of the Special Certification of Appropriateness for the alteration of the historic street grid and the introduction of a vehicular roundabout at Coral Way and Anderson; and

WHEREAS, on May 16th, 2023, the Transportation Advisory Board recommended approval of the roundabout on Coral Way and Anderson, as recommended by staff, along with the lighting recommendations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. That the foregoing “Whereas” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That the Transportation Advisory Board recommends the City Commission approve the proposed roundabout on Coral Way and Anderson, as recommended by City Staff, including the lighting recommendations.

SECTION 3. That said Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
