A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE CHIEF PROCUREMENT OFFICER TO AWARD THE PURCHASE OF TRASH RECEPTACLES TO TIGER COMPANIES, INC., THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE AND RESPONSIBLE BIDDER, IN THE ANNUAL ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF \$68,000.00, PURSUANT TO INVITATION TO BIDS (IFB) 2025-007 AND SECTION 2-763 OF THE CITY'S PROCUREMENT CODE ENTITLED "CONTRACT AWARD".

WHEREAS, on April 11, 2025, the Procurement Division of Finance formally advertised, issued and distributed the IFB for Purchase of Trash Receptacles; and

WHEREAS, thirteen (13) prospective bidders were notified through INFOR, the City's web-based e-procurement system; and

WHEREAS, on May 2, 2025, six (6) bids were received, including one (1) no bid in response to the IFB: DIRTT Environmental Solutions, Inc., (no bid), Landscape Forms, Northrock Enterprises, LLC., Southern Park and Play, LLC., Tiger Companies, Inc., and Victor Stanley, LLC; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department concurs with the Chief Procurement Officer's recommendation to award the Purchase of Trash Receptacles to Tiger Companies, Inc; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-585 of the Procurement Code, entitled "Authority" authorizes the City Manager to delegate authority to the Procurement Officer to administer and make recommendations on contract awards.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

Section 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

Section 2. That the City Commission accepts the recommendation of the Chief Procurement Officer authorizing the City Manager to award the Purchase of Trash Receptacles to Tiger Companies, Inc., the lowest responsive and responsible bidder in the estimated amount of \$68,000.00 but not to exceed the available budget throughout the life of the contract for a period of two (2) years with three (3) one (1) year renewals, pursuant to Invitation for Bids (IFB) 2025-007 and section 2-763 of the procurement code entitled "contract award"; further authorizing the purchase of additional units based on the available budget.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption herein.
