RESOLUTION NO. 2025-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT AGREEMENT NO. 3X247 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,000 FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT THROUGH THE DRONE REPLACEMENT PROGRAM; AND APPROPRIATING THE FUNDS TO BE PUT TOWARDS THE COST OF THE PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, Section 934.50, Florida Statutes establish rules, regulations and security standards for the use of drones by governmental entities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Rule 60GG-2.0075, Florida Administrative Code, the Department of Management Services has published minimum security standards for drones used by governmental entities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coral Gables Police Department has five drones that do not meet the updated security standards, as the drones were purchased prior to the implementation of these standards; and

WHEREAS, the City applied for and has been awarded financial assistance through the Florida Department of Law Enforcement Drone Replacement Program in the amount of \$100,000, \$25,000 per drone; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager and/or his designee is authorize to execute the grant agreement and any modification or amendments; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. That the foregoing “Whereas” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon the adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. The City Commission does hereby authorize the acceptance Grant Agreement No.3X247 from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement in the amount of \$100,000.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager is authorized to execute this amendment, as well as any future amendments, or change orders to this agreement.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
