**RESOLUTION NO. 2012-22**

**RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE CHIEF PROCUREMENT OFFICER TO EXTEND THE TROLLEY OPERATIONS CONTRACT WITH FIRST TRANSIT, INC., PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-829 OF THE PROCUREMENT CODE ENTITLED "APPROVAL OF CHANGE ORDERS AND CONTRACT MODIFICATIONS" FROM FEBRUARY 20, 2012, ON A MONTH-TO-MONTH BASIS FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED THREE (3) MONTHS TO PROVIDE TIME FOR A NEW TROLLEY OPERATIONS CONTRACT TO BE EXECUTED.**

**WHEREAS**, on September 12, 2006, the City Commission approved a three (3) year contract with First Transit, Inc., to provide trolley operation services, which provided for a negotiated extension for an additional two (2) years; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 27, 2009, this contract was extended based on a negotiated extension until November 20, 2011; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 11, 2011, the City Commission approved an extension of this contract to provide time to solicit proposals and to execute and new contract; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Procurement Officer recommends that the current contract be extended from February 20, 2012, on a month-to-month basis for a period not to exceed three (3) months to provide additional time for the Request for Proposal (RFP) process to be completed and for a new contract to be approved and executed; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 2-650 of the Procurement Code authorizes the City Manager to delegate authority to the Chief Procurement Officer to administer and make recommendations on City contracts; and

**WHEREAS**, the Trolley Operations Contract with First Transit, Inc., may be extended under Section 2-829 of the Procurement Code entitled "Approval of Change Orders and Contract Modifications";

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:**

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

**SECTION 2.** That the City Commission accepts the recommendation of the Chief Procurement Officer authorizing an extension of the Trolley Operations Contract with First Transit, Inc., pursuant to Section 2-829 of the Procurement Code entitled "Approval of Change Orders and Contract Modifications" from February 20, 2012, on a month-to-month basis for a period not to exceed three (3) months to provide additional time for the Request for Proposal (RFP) process to be completed and for a new contract to be approved and executed.

**SECTION 3.** That all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions inconsistent with, or in conflict herewith, shall be and are hereby repealed insofar as there is conflict or inconsistency.

**SECTION 4.** This resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.


