

**CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA**

**RESOLUTION NO. 2009-227**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN ENCUMBERANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$37,119.30, OR FIFTEEN PERCENT (15%) OF THE STATE FORFEITED ASSET FUND (HEREINAFTER AFTER REFERRED TO AS F.A.F.) MONIES TO PROVIDE FOR THE SUPPORT AND OPERATION OF CRIME PREVENTION, DRUG ABUSE EDUCATION AND PREVENTION, SAFE NEIGHBORHOOD OR SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER PROGRAMS, AS REQUIRED UNDER SECTION 932.7055 FLORIDA STATUTES, THE FLORIDA CONTRABAND FORFEITURE ACT.

**WHEREAS**, The Coral Gables Police Department's investigations of criminal activity result in the seizure and forfeiture of assets, both related and unrelated to its participation in the South Florida Money Laundering Strike Force operations, and

**WHEREAS**, the Coral Gables Police Department may lawfully retain at the conclusion of the legal proceedings the forfeited assets as authorized under the Florida Contraband Forfeiture Act, and

**WHEREAS**, the Coral Gables Police Chief, Richard J. Naue Jr., and the Coral Gables Finance Director, Donald G. Nelson, attest to have deposited the sum of \$37,119.30 in said forfeited assets into the Coral Gables Forfeited Asset Fund, and

**WHEREAS**, the F.A.F. Committee met on August 10, 2009, and followed the F.A.F. Committee operating procedures adopted on July 23, 2002, and

**WHEREAS**, The F.A.F. Committee approved the Coral Gables Police Chief's request to encumber the available funds on the specific items listed below on this Resolution;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:**

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption herein.

**SECTION 2.** That the City Manager is hereby directed to authorize the Finance Director to encumber \$37,119.30, from the State Forfeiture Proceeds of the F.A.F. to support or operate crime prevention, drug abuse education and prevention, safe neighborhood or youth resource officer programs, as required by Section 932.7055, Florida Statutes, of the Florida Contraband Forfeiture Act.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.


