**ITEM TITLE:**

A resolution directing the City Manager and City Staff to undertake a study of the possible annexation to the City of Coral Gables of the areas known as "Little Gables," "Ponce-Davis," and "High Pines," and provide a report to the City Commission.

**BRIEF HISTORY:**

Interest has been expressed in the annexation to the City of Coral Gables of the areas known as "Little Gables," "Ponce-Davis," and "High Pines." In order to determine whether the annexation of these areas is in the best interest of the City and the public, a study of these areas should be conducted. As part of said study a fiscal impact to the City's annexation of these areas should be included, along with an analysis of the impacts to City departments such as Police, Parks, Fire, Public Works, Planning and Zoning, and Building of these annexations. Importantly, this study should occur prior to initiating the procedure with Miami-Dade County to seek annexation of these areas.
