

ITEM TITLE:

A Resolution of the City Commission of Coral Gables, Florida directing the City Manager to transmit the City's 2024-2025 Adopted Budget to the Florida Department of Government Efficiency for Review and Recommendations

(Sponsored by Commissioner Fernandez)

BRIEF HISTORY:

On February 24, 2025, Governor Ron Desantis issued Executive Order 25-44, creating a Department of Government Efficiency ("Florida DOGE") within the Office of Policy and Budget in the Executive Office of the Governor. Executive Order 25-44 charges Florida DOGE with recommending legislative reforms to promote efficiency, maximize productivity, and eliminate waste in state and local government.

The City of Coral Gables has long been committed to fiscal responsibility and the prudent management of public resources. This commitment has resulted in Coral Gables being one of only three municipalities in Florida holding AAA bond ratings from Moody's, Standard & Poor's, and Fitch Ratings.

In furtherance of the City's demonstrated commitment to fiscal responsibility and the prudent management of public resources, the City Commission desires to voluntarily submit the City's 2024-2025 Adopted Budget to Florida DOGE for review and recommendations on potential efficiencies and waste reduction.
