
"No Parking" Signs SOP

"NO PARKING" SIGNS SOP

The proliferation of signage may result in reducing the effectiveness of the message signs convey related to critical information for the health, safety, and welfare of the community for both residents and pass-by travelers going through residential areas to other destinations. Excessive signs can become an unsightly nuisance, which may distract drivers and other users of the right-of-way (ROW).

For these reasons, the City will typically not install "No Parking" signs along residential streets unless there is a persistent and demonstrable parking and safety issue.

"No Parking" signs will be considered only in areas located within 1/10 mile (528 feet) from a school, park, commercial/institutional use, or multifamily residential developments, unless;

❖ Documentable safety concerns exist: impairing the visibility of drivers, cyclists and pedestrians; parking on sidewalks; blocking access to driveways, mailboxes, and solid waste

collection; safety crash history.
